




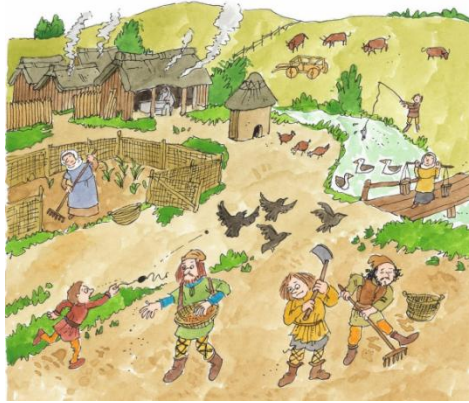


How did the arrival of the Romans change Britain?

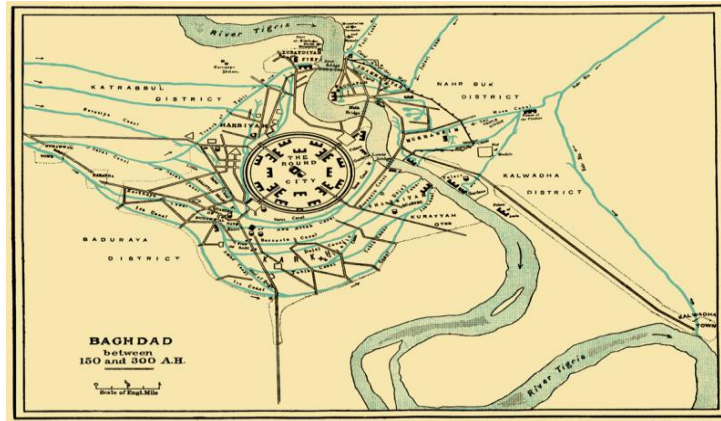
